She placed first in the TNUA admissions ranking but decided to pursue her studies at NTNU. Her achievements include multiple competition wins in both solo piano and chamber music, along with several NTNU awards and scholarships earned throughout her studies. Yi-Fang has studied under the tutelage of renowned pianists, such as Chia-Chi Hsu and Shu-Jen Mu. Additionally, she has had the privilege of participating in masterclasses and receiving coaching from esteemed musicians, including Pi-Hsien Chen, Ellen Mack, Jean-Marc Luisada, Ning An, Jahja Ling, Alexander Garvylyuk, and Kuokman Lio.

Yi-Fang has also thrived as a piano accompanist and has collaborated with various opera production teams on numerous operas, including works by G. C. Menotti, M. Ravel, R. Strauss, G. Puccini, and C.
